



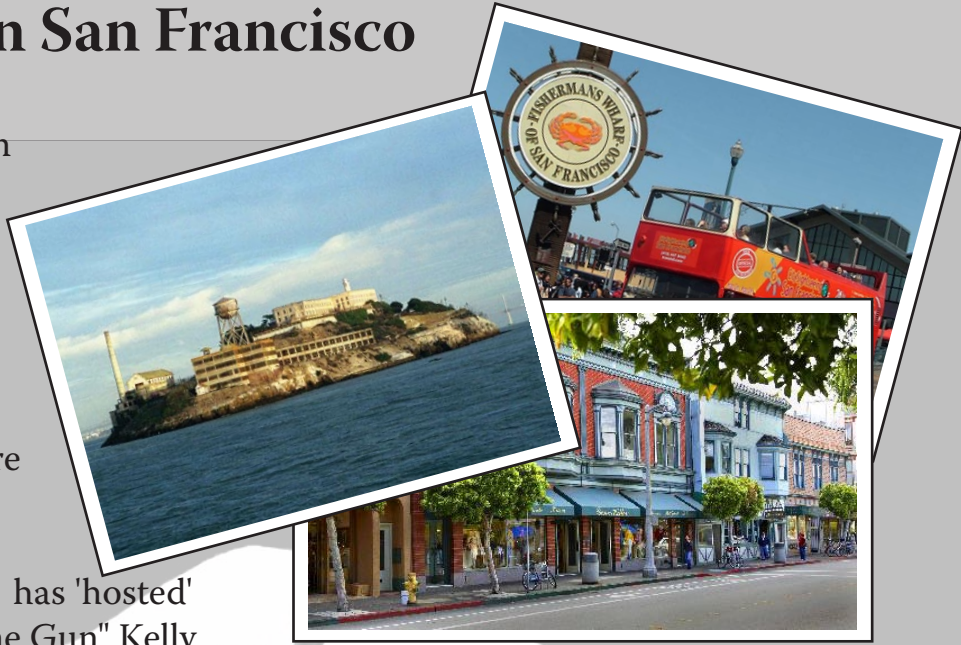
# IPAT 2012 Biennial Tours

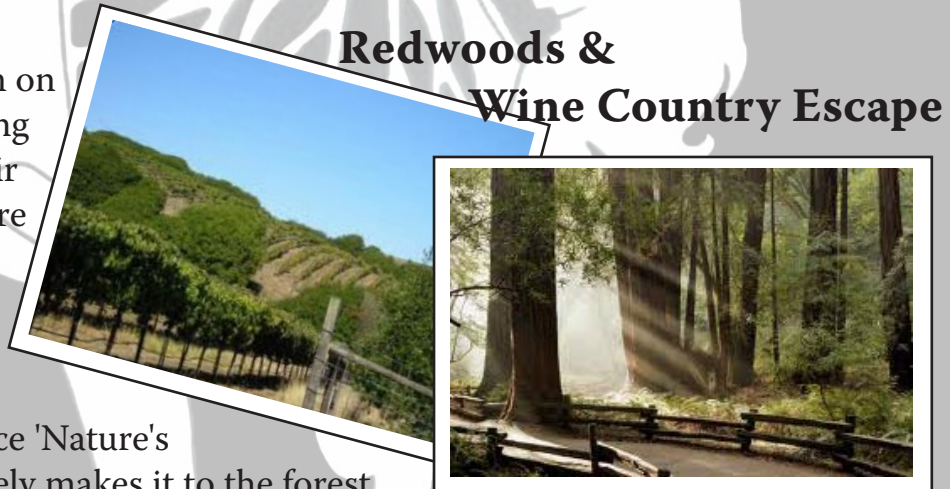
